### Overall Grand Rules:

1. The 30 & Older Divisional Winners have the option to compete in the 18 & Older Overall Weapons Grands and the 18 & Older Forms Grands but they would have to compete in the 18-29 CMX or Traditional Grand Championships and place in the top two just like the 18-29 competitors. If the 30 & Older Competitors option to do this, they forfeit their option to compete in the 30 & Older Weapons and Form Grands.
2. If a competitor wins both the Traditional Grand and CMX Grand, a promoter can selected an additional competitor/s to have four competitors in the Overall Grand Finals.
3. A Competitor does not have to preform with the same Form or Weapons routine in the Overall Grands as they used to win the regular Grands but they must perform with the same style of form (CMX or Traditional).
